INDEMNIFICATION

The following shall be a condition of all ATV/UTV permits:

Applicant shall save and hold County, its officers, employees, agents, and all private and governmental contractors and subcontractors with the county Wis. Stat. ch. 84, harmless from and against all liability, damage, loss, expense, claims, demands. and actions of any nature whatsoever (including any by Applicant itself) which arise out of or are connected with, or are claimed to arise out of, or be connected with any of the work done by Applicant or the construction or maintenance of facilities by Applicant pursuant to this permit or any other permit issued by County for location of property, lines, or facilities on highway right-of-way, (1) while Applicant is performing its work or (2) while any of Applicant's property, equipment, or personnel are in or about such place or the vicinity thereof or (3) while any property constructed, placed, or operated by or on behalf of Applicant remains on County's property or right-of-way pursuant to this permit or any other permit issued by County for location of property, lines, or facilities on highway right-of-way; including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, all liability, damages, loss, expense, claims, demands and actions on account of personal injury, death or property loss to County, its officers, employees, agents, contractors, subcontractors, or frequenters; to Applicant, its employees, agents, contractors, subcontractors, or frequenter; or to any other persons, whether based upon or claimed to be based upon, statutory (including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, worker's compensation), contractual, tort, or other liability of Applicant or any other persons and whether or not caused or claimed to have been caused by active or inactive negligence or other breach of duty by Applicant its employees, agents, contractors, subcontractors, or frequenters. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the liability, damage, loss, expense, claims, demands, and actions indemnified against shall include all liability, damage, loss, expense, claims, demands, and actions for damage to any property, lines, or facilities placed by or on behalf of Applicant pursuant to this permit or any other permit issued by County for location of property, lines, or facilities on highway right-of-way in the past or present or that are located on any highway or county property or right-of-way with or without a permit issued by County for any loss of data, information, or material; for trademark, copyright, or patent infringement; for unfair competition or infringement of any other so-called "intangible" property right; for defamation, false arrest, malicious prosecution, or any other infringement of personal or property rights of any kind whatever. Applicant shall, at its own expense, investigate all such claims and demands, attend to their settlement or other disposition, defend all actions based thereon, and pay all charges of attorneys and all other costs and expenses of any kind arising from any such liability, damage, loss; claims, demands, and actions.

Any transfer, whether voluntary or involuntary, of ownership or control of any property constructed, placed, or operated by or on behalf of Applicant that remains on County's property or right-of-way pursuant to this permit shall not release Applicant from any of the indemnification requirements of this permit unless County is notified of such transfer in writing. Any acceptance by any other person or entity, whether voluntary or involuntary, of ownership or control of any property constructed, placed, or operated by or on behalf of Applicant that remains on County's property or involuntary, of ownership or control of any property constructed, placed, or operated by or on behalf of Applicant that remains on County's property or right-of-way pursuant to this permit shall include acceptance of all of the indemnification requirements of this permit by the other person or entity receiving ownership or control.

Applicant, by execution of this application, does not waive any governmental or sovereign immunity. Both Applicant and County retain all applicable governmental immunities, defenses, and statutory limitations available including Wis. Stat. §§ 893.80, 895.52 and 345.05.



HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT

This Hold Harmless and Indemnification Agreement (Agreement) is entered into on this <u>day of</u>, 2024, by and between **SHEBOYGAN COUNTY**, a Wisconsin municipal corporation, by its Transportation Department with offices at W5741 County Road J, Plymouth, WI 53073 (hereinafter referred to as **COUNTY**), and **DISCOVERY ENERGY, LLC.**, a Delaware limited liability company, maintaining its principal office at 200 Twin Oaks Drive, Kohler, Wisconsin 53044, (hereinafter referred to as **DISCOVERY ENERGY**).

RECITALS

WHEREAS, **COUNTY** operates a municipal airport located at N6180 Resource Drive, Sheboygan Falls, WI 53085 (Airport); and

WHEREAS, DISCOVERY ENERGY seeks to test new lawn mowers on the fields at the Airport; and

WHEREAS, DISCOVERY ENERGY'S testing at the Airport provides a benefit to the public in that grass cutting is performed at no cost to the **COUNTY** or its residents.

AGREEMENT

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the terms contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, **COUNTY** and **DISCOVERY ENERGY** agree as follows:

1. <u>**Recitals Incorporated</u>**. The Recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and are made an enforceable part of this Agreement.</u>

2. <u>Area of Testing</u>. DISCOVERY ENERGY may mow the lawn and field areas of the Airport as approved by the Airport Superintendent. DISCOVERY ENERGY may use Gate 1 to enter the Airport property and may store equipment inside of the gate in an area designated by the Airport Superintendent. DISCOVERY ENERGY agrees that the gates will be closed or monitored by DISCOVERY ENERGY at all times, except when DISCOVERY ENERGY is passing through, to prevent unauthorized access to the Airport.

3. <u>Hold Harmless; Indemnification</u>. DISCOVERY ENERGY does hereby agree to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless COUNTY, its elected or appointed officers, employees, agents, inspectors, and attorneys from and against any and all liability, claims, demands, suits, actions, proceedings, losses, costs, and damages of every kind, including reasonable attorneys' fees and litigation costs, which may be brought or made against COUNTY, its elected or appointed officers, employees, agents, inspectors, and attorneys, from judgments, costs, expenses, including attorneys' fees and litigation costs, which may arise in any manner or in connection with DISCOVERY ENERGY testing at COUNTY's Airport.

4. <u>Insurance Required</u>. **DISCOVERY ENERGY** shall maintain, during the duration of **DISCOVERY ENERGY** testing's activities, for the protection of **COUNTY** and **DISCOVERY ENERGY**, at least the following minimum insurance coverages which may be met through any combination of primary coverage or umbrella coverage:

- commercial general liability; \$1,000,000.00 per occurrence; \$2,000,000.00 aggregate;
- commercial automobile liability; \$1,000,000.00 per accident;
- worker's compensation as required by Wisconsin law.

The required insurance policies shall include, to the extent available, provisions preventing their cancellation, except as allowed under the applicable policy, without ten (10) days prior written notice to **COUNTY**. **DISCOVERY ENERGY** shall provide such evidence of insurance to **COUNTY** upon **COUNTY**'s request. **COUNTY** shall be named as an additional insured under **DISCOVERY ENERGY**'s insurance policy.

6. <u>Miscellaneous</u>.

A. Successors and/or Assigns. This Agreement and each and all of the terms, covenants, and conditions hereof shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the parties and their respective successors and/or assigns, and no third party other than such successor and/or assign shall be entitled to enforce any term, covenant, or condition of this Agreement or have any rights hereunder.

B. Entire Agreement. This Agreement represents the entire agreement of the parties. This Agreement may not be modified, amended, or supplemented, except by mutual written agreement of the parties.

C. Waiver. No delay or omission by either of the parties hereto, or their successors, and/or assigns, to exercise any right or power accruing upon any non-compliance or failure of performance by another party under the provisions of this Agreement shall impair any such right or power or be construed to be a waiver thereof. A waiver by either of the parties hereto, or their successors and/or assigns of any of the covenants, conditions, or agreements hereof shall not be construed to be a waiver of any succeeding breach thereof or of any other covenant, condition, or agreement herein contained.

D. Severability. If any provisions or portions thereof, of this Agreement, or the application thereof to any person or circumstances shall, to any extent, be invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement, or the application of such provision, or portion thereof, to any other persons or circumstances shall not be affected thereby and each provision of this Agreement shall be valid and enforceable to the fullest extent permitted by law.

E. Headings. The headings appearing in this Agreement are for convenience and reference only, and in no way define or limit the scope and content of this Agreement or in any way affect its provisions.

F. Counterparts; Facsimile and E-mail Signatures. This Agreement may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which together will constitute one and the same instrument. Facsimile signatures and scanned signatures sent by electronic mail (e-mail) on this Agreement or any related documents shall have the same effect as original signatures. This Agreement and any documents related hereto shall be deemed fully executed upon

signing by all Parties in any combination of original, facsimile (fax), and scanned signatures.

G. Term. This Agreement is valid from _____, 2024 through _____, 2027.
