Chairperson Vandersteen called the meeting to order. Kay Lorenz verified that the meeting notice was posted on June 17, 2010 at 12:00 P.M. in compliance with the open meeting law.

Supervisor Holub made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 25, 2010 Executive Committee meeting as mailed. Motion seconded by Supervisor LeMahieu. Motion carried.

The Committee discussed a draft resolution entitled, "Supporting an Independent Study of Wisconsin's Economic Development Competitiveness and Positioning, Conducted by the Wisconsin Economic Development Association (WEDA), Competitive Wisconsin, Inc.
