The Committee reviewed the conditional approval previously granted to Airworthy Aviation regarding work area minimum size and number of employees on staff. Motion by Supervisor Holub and seconded by Supervisor Conrardy to grant Airworthy Aviation a one year conditional variance approval. Motion carried.

Chris Roenitz from the Sheboygan County Aviation Corporation (SCAC) requested that the Transportation Committee support SCAC's request to secure a concessionaires license. Said license needs to be approved by the Town of Sheboygan Falls before the state will issue one. The Committee requested that this matter be reviewed by County Corporation Counsel and be brought back to the Committee on July 12 or August 2<sup>nd</sup>.

No FBO report.

The Committee reviewed the FAA air traffic control tower services agreement. Supervisor Holub and seconded by Supervisor Conrardy to authorize the Chairperson to sign, contingent upon final document approval from Corporation Counsel. Motion carried.

The Committee reviewed the aircraft rescue and fire fighting services agreement with Pre-Tec Fire Services. Motion by Supervisor Holub and seconded by Supervisor Conrardy to authorize the Committee Chairperson and Airport Manager to sign, contingent upon final document approval from Corporation Counsel. Motion carried.

Airport Manager Mayer updated the Committee on the three alternative interchange locations (east) as proposed by WDOT as part of the WI 23 freeway designation and corridor preservation study (stakeholders meeting of June 29). An interchange at either CTH "TT (E-2), Highland Road (E-1) or at Bridgewood Road (E-3). At this time, the Town of Sheboygan Falls and City of Plymouth Officials are backing the E-3 location.

Airport Manager Mayer updated the Committee on the runway 13-31 re-build project. Project still remains on schedule and paving will start this week.

Motion by Supervisor Winkel and seconded by Supervisor Conrardy to adjourn at 10:07 a.m. Motion carried.
