A question has been raised as to whether the Health and Human Services Committee would consider this Resolution. Tom will bring the Resolution to the Committee for formal discussion and possible action at the next meeting.

Tom Eggebrecht informed the Committee there are no new updates on moving the Intoxicated Driver Intervention Contract for Services with Wisconsin Community Services (WCS) from the Jail to Health and Human Services as more information is needed.

Tom Eggebrecht informed the Committee that Wisconsin Way will no longer be on the agenda as the Committee received a report on Wisconsin Way in their July issue of the <u>Wisconsin Counties</u> magazine. A copy of the article will be sent to the Citizen Members of the Committee.
