

## **SHEBOYGAN COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MINUTES**

The Sheboygan County Transportation Committee convened at 9:30 a.m. Chairman Winkel presiding. Chairman Winkel noted that the meeting was posted on April 5, 2012 at 3:45 p.m. in the lobby of the Administration Building in compliance with the open meeting law.

It was moved by Supervisor Holub and seconded by Supervisor Conrardy to approve the minutes of the April 2, 2012 Transportation Committee meeting. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schnell advised of correspondence he received from Senator Joe Leibham on AB 518 regarding scenic byways legislation.

Ryan Sazama of the City of Sheboygan discussed the redesign of CTH "LS" and Eisner Avenue intersection 4 way stop sign and speed reduction. Supervisor Conrardy made a motion and Supervisor Wegner seconded the motion to have Commissioner Schnell perform a speed study and request Corporation Counsel draft an ordinance with a potential speed reduction and 4-way stop at CTH "LS" and Eisner Avenue. Roll call vote with Supervisors Winkel, Holub, Wegner, and Conrardy voting "AYE" and Supervisor Bemis voting "NAY", motion carried.

Commissioner Schnell presented AB 501 and SB 401 regarding changes to provide an exception to allow certain vehicles or vehicle combinations transporting manure to or from a farm, without a permit, to exceed weight limits by not more than 15% from September 1 to November 30 of each year. Commissioner Schnell advised of a potential solution of converting an affected area into a one way road on a temporary basis specifically for manure hauling.

Commissioner Schnell presented a request for the Hingham Memorial Walk/Run on Saturday, May 28, 2012. Supervisor Conrardy made a motion and Supervisor Bemis seconded the motion to with the understanding that they would be responsible for obtaining the appropriate liability insurance, make contact with all relevant local municipalities and if the highway department was called on to work outside of normal business hours they would be responsible for any overtime and equipment charges. Motion carried.

Commissioner Schnell discussed the results of the sale of Highway Department items that were on Wisconsin Surplus.

Commissioner Schnell discussed the plans for the parking lot at that main shop, the painting and carpeting of the main office, clean-up of the shop and the location of the various crews and projects.

Motion by Supervisor Bemis and seconded by Supervisor Conrardy to adjourn at 10:15 A.M.
